



MESH WINDSTOPS (MGB OR MIDGET)

The mesh windstop makes a stylish feature behind the seats in the cockpit, with its leather binding in either black or a choice of nine other colours. It still allows use of a half tonneau cover (hood cover) on MGs with folding hoods. Available in MGB/MGC and 1967 onwards Midget/Sprite versions, the windstop easily attaches to the hood frame mounting points in the cockpit and either folds back or may be removed from the car when not in use.

Highly effective in shielding the car's occupants from wind buffeting and backdraft, windstops have become extremely popular since the product's inception a few years ago.

If you don't like wearing a cap or hat while driving and find the only drawbacks of the otherwise exhilarating open-top motoring style are hair lashing at your eyes and both you and your partner suffering from 'bad hair days' every time you get out of the car, a windstop is the perfect solution.



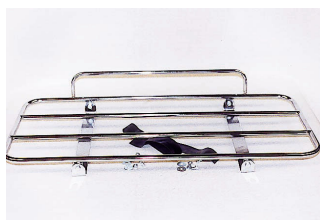

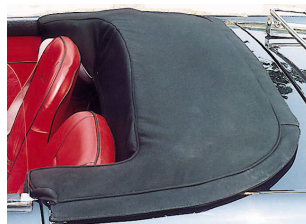
