

DOOR PANEL CLIP PACK MGB (PACK OF 10)

Acetal plastic trim clip, used to hold door trim panels to the doors on MGBs and GTs. Also has many other trim-retaining applications in 1970s onwards British motor cars, most noteably the Mini.

It doesn't matter how gently you try to do it, the removal of the trim panel from an MGB door during maintenance or repair work always results in one or more broken clips - and you've never got a spare one when you need one! Not a bad idea to have a pack sitting in a jar on the 'nuts and bolts' shelf in the garage.

Sold in packs of ten (or individually, if desired - contact MGOC Spares), the quantity required per door on the MGB is thirteen.



Easy to fit. The head of each clip can be inserted by hand in the pre-cut holes in the backboard of the trim panel, following which the panel may be fixed to the car body with firm hand pressure. 1970 onwards MGB doors, plus all new replacement doors are pre-pierced, ready to accept the clips.
