LEATHER CONSOLE WITH LEATHER PANELS MGB 1976-80

One-piece leather-trimmed Club design, modelled with the centre console features appropriate for MGBs and MGB GTs built between 1976 and 1980 and fitting as a direct replacement for the standard plastic console found in those cars. Provides an ergonomic place to site switches for accessories such as auxilliary lamps, electric windows, heated seats etc.

Beautifully crafted in hand-finished leather, the console is supplied with the switch/radio panel also trimmed in leather. Armrest and ashtray are not included, but may be fitted if desired. The leather console is available in six colours, matching other Club leather trim products.

Most effective as part of a cockpit leather upgrade - other leather-trimmed items that may be purchased include armrest, gear lever gaiter, console extension panels and door cappings. Together with Club leather seats and a Club Classic leather panel set, the result is simply sumptuous.



Easy to fit. Secures to the under-dash reinforcement with four self tapping screws and clips, the centre is held to the tunnel by the gear lever gaiter retaining ring and four screws, while the cubby box is held to the tunnel by a single screw.

FITTING INSTRUCTIONS



Basic hand tools required. A set of crosshead screwdrivers, plus possibly a pad and pencil to note down wiring positions on terminals of electrical equipment being transferred to the new console, if required. An awl and box spanner (or deep socket) will be required to deal with heater knobs and rotary controls respectively.
