

VINYL DOOR CAPPINGS MGB ROADSTER 1970-80 (PAIR)

Original style vinyl covered door cappings correct for MGB roadsters from 1970 onwards (i.e. Leyland era cars with push button exterior door handles). These cappings differ from earlier roadster cappings in being slightly thicker and more deeply padded - they are however completely interchangeable with cappings for 1964-70 cars and may be fitted to those models.

The door cappings are shown to best effect when fitted with new chrome brackets, while also purchasing the Club capping bracket screw set gives an MGB owner everything they need to fit the cappings to the doors without the hassle of having to work out what's required and order all the parts separately - see the recommendations below.

Available in pairs, in a choice of six colours to match the base colour options of original style Classic panel kits, Club panel kits and Club seats or seat covers.



Easy to fit. Even easier if you use nice new screws from the Club capping bracket screw set. Simply screw the brackets to the back of each capping and then screw the cappings to the door shells.



Basic hand tools required. A set of crosshead screwdrivers, plus a drill to make screw holes in new doors (if required).
