

LEATHER SEAT COVERS MGB & MGB GT 1973-80 (PAIR)

Classically styled luxury leather seat covers, specially designed to fit the profiles and contours of seats in 1973-80 MGBs and GTs. A great upgrade from original vinyl or cloth seat covers and a superb solution to the question of replacing worn-out 'deck chair' covers in later cars. Available in an amazing choice of twenty-one colour schemes (twelve with contrasting piping) to bring to life your dream interior customisation.

Featuring all-leather facings with plain side panels and a traditional seven-pleat centre panel design evocative of MGs of the 1950s and 60s, these seat covers will look perfectly at home in your MG and lift the cabin ambience to the level you desire. Especially effective with a Club Classic panel set in leather or vinyl (in the same wide choice of colours) and a Club burr walnut or elm dashboard, centre console and door cappings. That great British wood and leather effect at its best!

Headrests, purchased separately, are also available in the full range of matching colours.



Moderate skills required. Covers fit to the frames with clips. Cover centre panels need to be attached to foam centres to get the right bolster contours - this requires patience and a bit of upholstery adhesive.

FITTING INSTRUCTIONS



Basic hand tools required. Upholstery adhesive for the centre panels, snipe-nosed pliers or similar plus a small tack hammer and softwood block to fit the clips. A pair of upholstery pliers really help in gently pulling material taut over the foam and frame before fitting the clips (they also double-up as a tack hammer - a very useful tool!). Cross-head screwdriver to refit reclining handle.
