

VELOUR SEAT COVERS MIDGET & SPRITE 1970-79 (PAIR)

Classically styled, excellent value velour seat covers to the same design as the Club leather seat covers, specially designed to fit the profiles, contours and reclining mechanism of seats in 1970 onwards Midgets and Sprites. A great alternative to the vinyl original seat covers for those models, available in black, black with red piping, black with green piping and brown.

Featuring plain side panels and a traditional seven-pleat centre panel design evocative of MGs of the 1950s and 60s, these velour seat covers will look perfectly at home in your 1970s Midget or Sprite whilst helping to emphasise its illustrious heritage. Especially effective with a Club panel set and a Club burr walnut or burr elm dashboard and door cappings.

Velour headrest covers, purchased separately, are also available in a range of matching colours and the correct 'D' shaped profile.



Moderate skills required. Covers fit to the frames with clips. Cover centre panels need to be attached to foam centres to get the right bolster contours - this requires patience and a bit of upholstery adhesive.



Basic hand tools required. Upholstery adhesive for the centre panels, snipe-nosed pliers or similar plus a small tack hammer and softwood block to fit the clips. A pair of upholstery pliers really help in gently pulling material taut over the foam and frame before fitting the clips (they also double-up as a tack hammer - a very useful tool!). Cross-head screwdriver to refit reclining handle.
